Introduction

- This presentation shows the amount and type of gold, silver, and minor (copper) coinage from 1791 to 2020
 - Coinage was authorized in 1791, but no coinage made until 1793
 - Gold coinage was abolished in 1933
 - Silver coinage was debased permanently in 1965, and no longer contains any silver
 - From 1966 to the present, have only "token" coins of nickel and zinc, with trace amounts of copper

Preliminary Comments

- The following charts show two sets of data
 - Gold coinage
 - Silver and "minor" (i.e., copper) coinage
- The units are always in dollars, not the number of coins minted
 - Example: \$1,385,000.00 in \$10 Eagles coined in 1916 = 138,500 physical coins
- Gold coin denominations: \$10 Eagle, \$20 Double Eagle, Three Dollar, \$2.50 Quarter Eagle, Gold Dollars
- Silver coin denominations: Trade Dollars, Dollars, Half Dollars, Quarters, Twenty-Cents, Dimes, Three-Cents
- Minor denominations: Nickels, Cents
- The chart intervals correspond to changes in the banking system per *The Control and Manipulation of Money*

Monetary Legislation

- The dollar was originally defined as a weight of silver in 1791
- The defining weight was changed several times throughout the 1800's
- The U. S. was on a de-facto gold standard from 1879 to 1900, when it was formalized as a weight of gold
- The domestic dollar was divorced from the gold standard in 1933, although technically was still defined as varying weights of gold
- The history of monetary legislation is detailed in Part 2 of *The Control and Manipulation of Money*

Gold Coinage, 1933

- In 1933, President Franklin D. Roosevelt confiscated all the gold coins in the U. S., so as to divorce the dollar from gold. From 1933 to 1971, the U. S. was on the "bullion standard", i.e., fiat domestically, but gold-based for foreign transactions. In 1971, President Richard M. Nixon removed the dollar from gold altogether, making the U. S. dollar entirely fiat.
- Prior to the confiscation, the U. S. minted in 1933 \$8,910,000.00 in \$20 Double Eagles and \$3,125,000.00 in \$10 Eagles.
